

VOTIVA WOMEN'S INTIMATE HEALTH

RECOMMENDATIONS BEFORE YOUR TREATMENT

We look forward to seeing you for your treatment! Until then, follow these recommendations to optimize your results.

- A gynecological examination must be carried out on the day of your treatment. A normal cytology result (Paptest) dating less than one year is also required. Please let us know if your cytology is over a year old or if you have received a cytology result abnormal in the past.
- For hygienic and sterility reasons, please shave pubic hair the day before your treatment.
- It is recommended to clean thoroughly the external parts at home on the day of the treatment, and to avoid the application of creams, lotions, perfumes, oils or powder on the skin before treatment.
- If possible, avoid anti-inflammatory drugs (Advil[®], Motrin[®], Celebrex[®], Naproxen[®], etc.) and Omega-3 3 days before your treatments.
- Plan the right time to perform the *Votiva*. It is acceptable to carry out the treatment in the event of menstruation. Nevertheless, for your comfort, you could contact us to reschedule your appointment in case of heavy gynecological bleeding.
- Avoid sexual relations in the 24 hours preceding your treatment.
- In the event of an **ongoing infection** or **antibiotics use**, please postpone your appointment.
- For greater comfort, you may take **2 tablets of acetaminophen (Tylenol®)** 500 mg one hour before your treatment.
